Entry Fees

First entry is \$20.00 per day; additional entries of same dog, same day are \$11.00. Entry fees include AKC recording fee of \$3.50 first entry/\$3.00 additional entry. Catalogs may be pre-ordered for \$10 on the entry form. A limited number will be available at the trial for \$15.

ONLINE ENTRIES: Online entries are available for these trials through AKC's Online Entry service. Go to www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow instructions there. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries per day designated as either online or paper will be **100** runs/trial via **online** entries, **230** runs/trial via **paper** entries. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

REFUNDS: A full refund of entry fees will be given for any reason if a written (or email) request is received by the Trial Secretary before closing. After closing, a refund of entry fees, less \$6.00 per day, will be given for a bitch that comes into season, if written (or email) notification is received by the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the trial.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. **Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate, provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Please designate the dog's breed as "All American" on the entry form.**

Important Information for Exhibitors -- PLEASE READ!

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone, fax, e-mail or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form, are not acceptable. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class for which it is not eligible, regardless of who makes such errors. The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as a result of completing a title, and correction of specific errors as provided in the *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 21*) after the closing date of the trial. **Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es). Contact the Trial Secretary if you have questions!**

Entries sent by express mailing services MUST have the delivery signature requirement waived; otherwise receipt may be delayed. Entries will not be considered as being received until they are delivered to the address given on the entry form. Please note the opening date of April 17, 2017; no entries will be accepted before that date. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in one envelope; envelopes containing entries for more than ten dogs will be considered invalid, and will be returned to the sender. No hand delivered entries can be accepted until 9:00 AM on April 18, 2017.

PHDF is using a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 25 entries (runs) will be placed on each trial's wait list. All entries must have been received by the Trial Secretary prior to closing on Wednesday, May 31, 2017 at 9:00 PM. Any entries withdrawn, with notification to the Trial Secretary in writing (e-mail is OK) by **6:00 PM on Monday, June 12, 2017** will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry; otherwise no refund will be given for withdrawn entries, except as specified above. Any wait listed entry that does not get into the trial will receive a full refund.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent (other than bitches in season as specified), disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

Confirmation of entry and judging schedule will be e-mailed (or sent by postal mail to the address on the official AKC entry form, if no e-mail is provided) after the closing date; if not received at least 7 days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. **Acknowledgment of receipt of entries prior to closing will be provided if the exhibitor provides a valid e-mail address on the entry form, or includes a stamped, self-addressed postcard or envelope with entry.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

The Palouse Hills Dog Fanciers and the Trial Secretary assume NO responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site and no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or designated warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

In the Regular classes, handlers may choose to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. In the Preferred classes, dogs may NOT run in a higher height division than that determined by their withers height.

If your dog needs to be measured, mark "yes" on the entry form, so that the Trial Secretary knows a measurement is needed. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in, but it is still the exhibitor's responsibility to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Regulations for Agility Trials, Ch. 2, Sect. 4.

Paula Ratoza is a VMO, so all dogs age 2 or over without a valid height card or two measurements after age 2, and all dogs under age 2 without a temporary measurement must be measured. You will need to fill out a form (provided at the trial) with your dog's identifying information prior to measurement.

Move-Up Information

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the handler, as a result of completing an agility title at an earlier event, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, in writing (e-mail is acceptable), by 6:00 PM on **Monday, June 12, 2017**. If a dog finishes a title during the trial, the handler may move up for the following days by filling out a move-up form (available at the event) and turning it in to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the end of judging for the day.

Site Information

These Agility Trials will be held outdoors on grass, ring size 100' by 100'. The rings will be fenced, with entry/exit openings. Water and portable toilets are on site. There is some shade, but please be prepared to provide shade for your dogs. And of course, we know you will uphold the great reputation of agility exhibitors by cleaning up after your dogs!

On Friday, the grounds will open for exhibitor setups starting at 12:00 noon. The club will be setting up the rings before noon, so please do not attempt to set up before that time. PLEASE NOTE: To protect the grass, MATTING is required under all crates and ex-pens.

Volunteer Workers

As you probably know, there are quite a variety of tasks that go along with holding an agility trial, and we greatly appreciate volunteers to help share the work load. We will have a white board for worker sign-up at the trials. Lunch will be provided for volunteers who work at least two classes in a day.

Equipment

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. Equipment is provided by Stride Ahead Agility. All contact obstacles and tables will have rubberized surfaces.

Awards

All awards are courtesy of Palouse Hills Dog Fanciers. A qualifying score is required for all awards, and no awards will be mailed. Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 4th place in each height division in each Regular and each Preferred class. Green ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores.

Each dog entered will receive a dog toy, valued at \$1 to \$5, available for pickup at the awards table. One toy per dog for the weekend, please!

Each day of the trial, PHDF offers "High in Class" awards for each Standard and JWW class in the Regular and Preferred divisions. The highest qualifying score over all jump heights within each class, with ties broken by the fastest yards per second, will be awarded a rosette and a certificate for \$10.00 in entry fees to a PHDF AKC agility trial in 2018.

All dogs earning a MACH or PACH title at these trials will receive a MACH or PACH bar and rosette. If you are close to earning an award, please let the Trial Chair know ahead of time, so that we are prepared to celebrate with you!

Directions to Trial Site

From the south: From HWY 95 N, turn RIGHT onto HWY 8 East (second light in Moscow). Go 1 mile to light at Eastside Marketplace Mall and turn LEFT onto Blaine St. Go one block, turn RIGHT on White Ave. Fairgrounds entrance is first road on LEFT.

From the north: Take HWY 95 S into Moscow (becomes one-way Jackson St.). At south end of town, street bends left (east). In left lane, go through light onto HWY 8 East. Go 1 mile to light at Eastside Marketplace Mall and turn LEFT onto Blaine St. Go one block, turn RIGHT on White Ave. Fairgrounds entrance is first road on LEFT.

From the west: On Hwy 195 S, take first Pullman exit. At light, turn RIGHT onto Grand Ave. At second light, turn LEFT onto one-way Paradise (becomes Main). Continue east on Main/WA 270 for about 7 miles. At ID border, WA 270 becomes ID HWY 8 East. Go 1 mile to light at Eastside Marketplace Mall and turn LEFT onto Blaine St. Go one block, turn RIGHT on White Ave. Fairgrounds entrance is first road on LEFT.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or **back-to-back trials** only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners** SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.
